Petitioner-Satnam Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.93 dated 31.10.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Moga, under Sections 307, 341 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has been named in the FIR and stated to be armed with pistol. He fired from the pistol and caused injuries to the complainant. He also fired second shot which hit on the back near left shoulder of Amandeep Singh, friend of the complainant.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the facts that the present petitioner is required for custodial interrogation and the pistol is yet to be recovered, I do not find it a fit case

where the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
