This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.203 dated 16.06.2006, registered under Sections 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Nakodar; order dated 27.03.2009, vide which the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender; and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that similarly situated co-accused, i.e. father of the petitioner, stands acquitted by the trial Court and the revision filed thereagainst also stands rejected. The judgment in revision has not been assailed so far. He cites '**Topandas Vs. State of**

Bombay', 1956 AIR (SC) 33, '**Jasvinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another'**, 2013(1) RCR (Criminal) 310 and '**Bhupinder Singh and others Vs. Jalandhar Development Authority and another'**, passed in CRM-M-9857-2014.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel states that the petitioner was earlier granted bail, however, during the pendency of the trial, the petitioner went abroad and subsequently, she was declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 27.03.2009. He further states that the challan has been filed.

Heard.

The petitioner is a proclaimed offender, has filed the present petition in absentia, the veracity of the document on the basis of which the present petition has been filed, remains questionable. Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has misused the concession of bail earlier granted to her, without going into the merits of the decided cases, this Court is not inclined to entertain the present petition.

Accordingly, the instant petition is dismissed.
