Petitioner seeks quashing of complaint and summoning order in case titled as “Mohinder Kaur Vs. Ninder Singh & others”. During the proceedings, matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre alongwith CRM-M-13727 of 2013. Accused and complainant Mohinder Kaur appeared before the Forum and were able to arrive at a amicable settlement. Same has been reduced into writing. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“9. That the parties undertake before the Hon'ble Court to abide by the terms and conditions set out in the agreement. It has been informed by both the parties that no other case is pending between the parties except the civil litigation mentioned above.

10. That the parties to this agreement hereby state that they have read the agreement, that they have understood the contents thereof and their execution of agreement is voluntary. Each party has relied upon or has had the opportunity to seek legal advice of their counsel.

11. With the execution of this agreement, each signatory acknowledges receipt of fully executed duplicate/original of this agreement.

12. That it has been further agreed between the parties that in case of necessity, both the parties shall be free to present the copy of the above compromise before any authority or Court if the same is required to witness the execution of the compromise or to settle any pending controversy between the parties.”

In view of above, learned counsel submit that no useful purpose will be served by continuance of criminal proceedings. Same may be quashed in light of *Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab, 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052*.

Prayer is accepted. The complaint and all proceedings consequent thereto, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.

Petition stands allowed.
