JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by Roop Chand-petitioner seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take action in FIR No. 167, dated 29.11.2015, Police Station Ismailabad, under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 IPC.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though FIR was registered on November 29, 2015 but till date no substantial investigation has been conducted. Even, the petitioner has also moved representation dated February 02, 2016 (Annexure P-6) but despite that

fact, no action has been taken.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is given to respondents No. 2 and 3 to consider representation (Annexure P-6) and to take appropriate action.

6. Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated February 02, 2016 (Annexure P-6) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
