Present 2nd petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner/accused-Manoj @ Anmol in case FIR No.392 dated 30.07.2014, under Sections 148, 302, 201, 435 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Hodal, District Palwal.

As per the allegations surfacing in the investigation, the petitioner/accused-Manoj @ Anmol is the main accused, who is alleged to have inflicted injuries along with other co-accused/non-applicants with *Knife*, causing the death of Ved Parkash.

From the M.L.R., it is noticed that there are as much as 13 injuries including one with sharp edged weapon.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 06.08.2014.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Karam Singh, submits that only one prosecution witness has been examined.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the allegations, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
