The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and that too at the hands of her in-laws.

Perusal of the pleadings on record would show that the averments made therein are utterly vague. No specific instances of harassment or physical assault have been made. Rather in para 10 of the petition, it has been stated that the respondents herein attacked the house of the friend of the petitioner namely Nachhatar Singh and had allegedly even kidnapped his mother and for such instance F.I.R No.143 under Section 365 I.P.C already stands registered against the father of the petitioner.

In the light of the pleadings on record, no directions are required to be passed in the instant petition.

Present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
