Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.83 dated 28.03.2015, under Sections 15/18/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery of 60 Kgs. of poppy husk and 100 grams of opium was effected from the residential premises of the present petitioner as also her husband co-accused, namely, Jaswinder Singh

The alleged recovery would be construed as marginally over and above the commercial quantity.

Co-accused, Jaswinder Singh has been granted the benefit of regular bail by this Court in the light of order dated 11.01.2016 passed in CRM No.M-41649 of 2015.

The petitioner is a lady, who is in custody since 28.03.2015. She is otherwise stated to be possessing clean antecedents and is not involved in any other proceedings under the NDPS Act.

Investigation in the present case is complete and the challan has been presented on 16.09.2015.

In an overview of the matter and without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
