Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that no compromise has been arrived at between him and the petitioners. A report has also been received from the trial court, which reads as under:-

“I have the honour to intimate that in the subject cited matter, no party has come present to record their statements regarding compromise in this court till today. This is for your kind information please.”

It has been pointed out by learned State counsel that investigation in the matter is still pending. Thus, present petition is not maintainable.

In view of the fact that compromise is denied by counsel for respondent No.2 and none appeared before the trial court to record statement, present petition is without any merit and hereby dismissed.
