JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No. 56 dated May 09, 2008 under Sections 409, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise alleged to have been arrived at between the complainant and petitioners.

2. At the very outset of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he does not press the relief for quashing of FIR in question, at this stage but prays that investigating agency be directed to submit cancellation report in the concerned Court for appropriate orders.

3. Though, it has been averred in the petition that cancellation report was presented in the Court of learned Jurisdictional Magistrate in the Month of May 2015 but no final order has been passed so far but in this regard, a report from the concerned officer was called. According to which, neither any cancellation report has been presented in his Court in the instant case nor the same is pending disposal.

4. Be that, as it may, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to Station House Officer, Police Station Mehna, District Moga to present the cancellation report within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in the Court of learned Jurisdictional Magistrate, Moga who shall deal with it and dispose of the same within a period of two months from the date of its receipt.
