This is the fifth petition preferred by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking ad interim bail for a period of four weeks so as to attend to his mother and who is stated to be suffering from a serious health ailment.

Suffice it to notice that the petitioner is an accused in FIR No.92 dated 03.06.2014, under Sections 21, 22, 25, 25-A, 27, 29, 61, 85 of NDPS Act and Sections 26, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Pasiana, District Patiala.

That apart the petitioner is also involved in a number of other cases under the NDPS Act.

Pleadings on record would show that identical prayer was dealt with on the last occasion by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM No. M-1137 of 2016 (Annexure P-6) and was declined on 16.03.2016 after calling for the filing of an affidavit of the Senior Superintendent of Police,

Barnala as also a report of the Civil Surgeon, Barnala. In the order dated 16.03.2016, directions have been issued to the Civil Surgeon, Barnala to provide an emergency medical assistance number to the parents of the petitioner so as to ensure that if there be need for any emergency medical assistance, the same be provided to them at State expense.

In the present petition, there is no material placed on record or for that matter even adverted to by the counsel during the course of hearing as regards the medical condition of the mother of the petitioner having deteriorated after 16.03.2016 so as to justify the filing of the instant petition.

We are constrained to observe that the present petition is nothing but an attempt to take a chance before the vacation Bench.

Petition is wholly misconceived and is, accordingly, dismissed.
