Admittedly, the petitioner was released on interim bail vide order dated 17.06.2016 on account of the fact that the report of the Chemical Examiner was awaited. The benefit of interim bail was granted till the receipt of the report of the Chemical Examiner, which is dated 24.09.2016.

Keeping in view the fact the interim bail was conditional and the petitioner chose not to appear on the date fixed, the present petition is not maintainable against the said order, as the interim concession granted has been violated. The petitioner having absented has led to the issuance of the non-bailable warrants.

It is always to the petitioner to appear before the Court concerned and seek his remedy in accordance with law for regular bail.

It is made clear that this Court has not observed anything on the merits of the case for which the petitioner would have an independent remedy.

With the abovesaid observations, the present petition stands disposed of.
