Report dated 18.03.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Jangi, Khula, Rahul and Karan as well as of complainant Vikram Malhotra it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is case of version and cross-version and that the parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not heinous in nature and that this compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in *Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR*

**Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, DDR No.39 dated 30.10.2014 as cross-version case in FIR No.210 dated 27.10.2014 under Sections 452,427,506,148,149 IPC Police Station, Division C, Amritsar City and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
