Report dated 31.7.2015 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barnala has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Ramesh Goyal as well as of complainant Jiwan Lal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is pure money dispute and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and**

another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052, FIR No.23 dated 19.02.2009
under Sections 420,465,467,471 IPC, Police Station, Tapa Mandi,
District Barnala and all other consequential proceedings arising
therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner No.2 Ramesh Goyal.

Petition stands disposed off.
