Prayer made in the instant petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No. 92, dated 28.02.2013 i.e. (Annexure P-1) under Section 506 of the IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Palam Vihar, Gurgaon.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from S.I. Naresh Kumar states that in FIR in question, the police has already prepared the cancellation report and same has been presented before the concerned Court for its consideration.

Since the police has already prepared a cancellation report and

submitted to the Court, the prayer of the petitioner no more survives and the present petition is disposed of as such.

However, it is made clear that in case the Court does not accept the cancellation report, the petitioner is at liberty to file fresh petition seeking quashing of the FIR.
