FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 20.02.2016 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Santokh Singh, Vajinder Singh, Sukhdev Singh @ Kala and Joginder Singh as well as of complainant Swaranjit Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a non-injury case and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.183 dated 18.07.2014 under

Sections 341,342,427,447,506,148,149 IPC and Sections 25,27,54,59 of Arms Act (later on deleted Section 25 of the Arms Act and Sections 148 and 149 IPC were added) Police Station, Kotwali Faridkot District Faridkot and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
