Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the police officials to take action against the private respondents in FIR No.307 dated 21.12.2015 under Section 302 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of complete sets of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that at this stage, he

would be satisfied in case respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur is directed to look into the contents of representation dated 31.12.2015 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and to take action in accordance with law expeditiously.
