The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking directions to the official respondents no.1 to 3 to conduct a fair, impartial and proper investigation in case F.I.R. No.134 dated 21.11.2015 under sections 323, 298, 379, 506, 427, 148, 149 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, City Gurdaspur.

Learned senior counsel would submit that the present petitioner was assaulted and sustained a number of injuries in an occurrence that allegedly took place on 21.11.2015.

The grievance portrayed is that the F.I.R in question has been registered on the statement of one Sh. Dashminder Kumar Noni, who is a Municipal Councilor and having allegiance to the ruling party in the State of Punjab. It is contended that the statement of the present petitioner who would actually be the aggrieved party has not been recorded and F.I.R has been registered at the instance of the complainant Dashminder Kumar only with an attempt to shield the accused.

Without even going into the merits of the case and without ascertaining the correctness of the averments contained in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to

respondent no.2 i.e. the S.S.P., District Gurdaspur to look into the grievance of the petitioner by treating the present petition itself as a representation and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.

Petition disposed of.
