This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. preferred by Rajender Singh seeking issuance of directions to official respondents to hand over the investigation in case FIR No. 18, dated 16.01.2014 to some independent agency i.e. special crime branch/special investigation agency like CBI.

Notice to respondents No.1 to 4 only, at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has moved number of representations to respondents No. 1 to 3, for getting the needful done but no action has been taken so far.

The instant petition is disposed of with directions to

respondent No.3- Superintendent of Police, Sonipat to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 13.10.2015 (Annexure P-6) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
