**HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)**

Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.52 dated 29.4.2011, under Sections 379, 353, 186, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar and the entire consequential proceedings arising thereof and pending before the learned trial Court at Jalandhar including the order dated 4.1.2014 framing charges (Annexure P-5) and the charge dated 4.1.2014 (Annexure P-6 colly).

Taking into consideration the advanced stage i.e. charges have been framed and the material witnesses have since been examined, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition, however, he submits that since the FIR was registered in the year 2011, the trial Court be directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same expeditiously.

Prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner seems justified.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. The petitioners are at liberty to take all possible pleas during the trial. The trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.
