Prayer in this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of three accused/petitioners, namely, Balwinder Singh alias Binda (petitioner No. 1 herein), Tarsem Singh (petitioner No. 2 herein) and Gurpreet Singh alias Hira (petitioner No. 3 herein) in case FIR No. 02, dated 05.01.2016, for offences punishable under Sections 308, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, District Batala.

It was contended that the alleged occurrence took place on 9.11.2015 at around 8.30 pm wherein Manpreet Singh suffered injuries. FIR was lodged after a delay of two months by the father-complainant levelling allegations against present three accused as well as mother of the injured Manpreet based on his suspicion and hearsay evidence. It was further contended that entire evidence is based on hearsay evidence and that apart only one injury has been found in the MLR of Manpreet.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the order dated 10.02.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Balwinder Singh, does not dispute the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation. He further states that the petitioners are no longer required for interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted to the petitioners by this Court's order dated 10.02.2016, is made absolute.

Disposed of.
