AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for the grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.122 dated 23.06.2013, under Sections 302, 307, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar.

Learned counsel has argued that the petitioner who is a girl of 22 years, has now been in custody since May, 2015. Learned Addl.AG, on instructions from ASI Amar Singh, states that three out of eight witnesses have already been examined and the prosecution undertakes to conclude its evidence by 23.12.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same).

In these circumstances this petition is dismissed at this stage but it is directed that in case the prosecution evidence is not concluded by

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23.12.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same) the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail to its satisfaction.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
