Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482,

Cr.P.C., is for quashing of FIR No.1263, dated 31.12.2013 (Annexure P-1), registered under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471, IPC, at Police Station, City Karnal, District Karnal, as well as all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise, dated 01.02.2015, (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion was issued to the respondents for 21.05.2015. On the adjourned date, i.e. 21.05.2015, the affected parties were directed to appear before learned Trial Court on 13.07.2015, for getting their respective statements recorded.

As per the report received from Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal, the parties to the *lis* did not appear before learned Trial Court for suffering their statements.

It appears that the private parties to the *lis* are no more interested in pursuing the present petition.

Learned counsel for the State has also pointed out that after investigation, cancellation report has been prepared and after taking proper sanction from the competent authority, the same would be presented before learned Area Judicial Magistrate, Karnal.
