The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 80 dated 11.02.2015 registered at Police Station Surajkund, Faridabad under Sections 363, 366-A IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations of kidnapping were against Kabir and the petitioner was not named in the FIR and subsequently the role given to the petitioner is that he had provided a room on rent in the village. He further contends that the investigation is over and charge has been framed.

The allegations levelled by the complainant were that Kabir had kidnapped his minor daughter. The statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. of the victim was recorded. She had stated that she had gone with Kabir on her own and they had got married and she was pregnant and wanted to live with Kabir. The role given to the petitioner later was that he had provided a room to Kabir.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
