Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Hanumant alleging that on 05.01.2015 he along with his driver Suraj Bhan was going in a Ritz car when 5-6 young persons waylaid them while coming in a Duster car and committed theft of their car, wallet and ATM cards on gun point.

The petitioner has not been identified by Suraj Bhan at trial and he was declared hostile. The identification of the petitioner for the first time in the Court has been done by complainant Hanumant Singh. The material witnesses having already been examined and the petitioner being in custody w.e.f. 04.04.2015, chances of tampering with the evidence are remote.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
