JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the two petitioners-brothers namely, Sonu and Kulbir in case FIR No.1212 dated 23.12.2015 for offence punishable under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered with Police Station City Karnal.

Accused Ashok Kumar and Vikram @ Vicky were apprehended by the police party and 10 grams of “Smack” was recovered from the pocket of accused Ashok Kumar. On their disclosure statement that they have purchased it from the present petitioners, they have been nominated as accused in the aforesaid FIR.

It is contended that except a bald statement there is nothing to connect the petitioners with the alleged offence. Further, neither any recovery has been effected from the petitioners nor are they involved in any other criminal case.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rohtash Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation, however has stated that they are not in possession of any contraband. He, however, states that the petitioners are not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 11th of February, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
