Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of F.I.R No. 67 of 22.07.2015, under Section 406/498-A/420 IPC, registered at P.S. Sadar Women, District Patiala.

The matter was referred to Mediation Centre after grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. As per report of the Mediator, petitioner could not appear before the Mediator and period of 90 days elapsed. Further, the complainant is not ready to take Rs.8 lacs as full and final settlement.

In view of the above position, order dated 17.03.2016 passed by this Court whereby the ad-interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall deposit a F.D of Rs.3 lacs before the trial Court in the name of the complainant within a period of one month. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so

and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. The decision with regard to release of the above said amount will be seen by the trial Court at the final stage.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to file fresh bail bonds after presentation of the challan.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
