Today, nobody is present on behalf of the petitioners and even the process fee has not been filed, which is a sufficient ground to dismiss the present petition for non-prosecution, however, learned counsel for the State has produced the statements of petitioner No.1-Gaurav Kalra son of Sh. Tilak Raj Kalra, as well as petitioner No.2-Arunakshi Thapa wife of Gaurav Kalra, wherein, they have stated that they do not have any threat to their life and

liberty from the other side. Statements of both the petitioners produced in Court today, are taken on record.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of.
