By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioners are seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 for registration of FIR against respondents No.6 to 14 as also against others who are found involved in the matter with regard to embezzlement/misappropriation of the public funds with further direction to get investigation conducted by independent agency preferably CBI.

During the pendency of the instant petition, FIR No.46 dated 3rd November, 2015, under Sections 406, 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and Section 13(1) (d) of Prevention of Corruption Act has been registered at Police Station SVB, Gurgaon. After registration of the FIR, the investigation has been entrusted to Special Investigating Team headed by DSP Jaivir Singh Rathee. As per the latest status report furnished by

way of affidavit of Mr. Parminder Rai, IPS, Director General, State Vigilance Bureau (H), Panchkula, the investigation is in progress.

In view of the status report submitted on behalf of State of Haryana, the instant petition has rendered infructuous. As such, it stands disposed of accordingly. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to approach this Court again if they are not satisfied with the investigation.
