Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.55 dated 1.2.2015 under Sections 186, 353, 379, 188 and 307 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Mangal Singh, submits that pursuant to orders dated 16.02.2016, 28.03.2016, 09.08.2016 and 19.10.2016 of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and conclusion of trial is likely to take sufficient long time, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 16.02.2016 is

made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
