Petitioner as a member of unlawful assembly, which was armed with baseball bats and iron rods, had allegedly attacked complainant Rajinder Singh and Gurwinder Singh. So far as petitioner is concerned, he is attributed two blows on the head of the complainant. There is no grievous injury on the head of the complainant. Five other accused have already been arrested. Petitioner having not been attributed any grievous injury and he having already joined investigation, he can be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest of the petitioner in the case he will be released subject to the conditions that the petitioners will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper investigation in any manner.
