Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.142 dated 04.08.2015, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 34 of Indian Penal Code, charges framed under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Patiala, District Patiala.

Counsel for the parties have been heard at length.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Amrik Singh in relation to an occurrence that took place on 04.08.2015. Injured in the present case is Mohinder Singh i.e. brother of the complainant. Accusations are that Mohinder Singh was assaulted by the present petitioner as also his father, namely, Jagdish Singh.

Present petitioner was stated to be armed with a spade and has been attributed specific blows with a spade on the nose,

throat and forehead to injured Mohinder Singh. The allegations find corroboration from the medical examination of injured. Injury attributed to the petitioner has been opined to be grievous in nature.

In the light of such serious allegations which stand corroborated by medical evidence, this Court is not inclined to grant benefit of regular bail to the petitioner at this stage.

Petition dismissed.
