Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Amritpal Singh @ Vicky in case FIR No.129 dated 21.12.2015, under Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

It was alleged by the complainant-Harpreet Kaur wife of deceased-Narvel Singh that her husband has committed suicide because of the pressure put by the present petitioner-Amritpal Singh @ Vicky and his father-Harjit Singh for return of amount of Rs.5 lacs.

It was contended that since deceased had taken loan from the petitioner and to discharge that liability, he had executed a sale deed qua agriculture land measuring 1 Kanal 4 Marlas and the remaining payment through a cheque for a sum of Rs.3 lacs. On presentation of the cheque, it was dishonoured. Thus, it was argued that no offence against petitioner is made out.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated. Even otherwise, the parties have amicably settled the dispute.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by H.C. Chanan Singh, submits that the complainants have given their statements that they are no longer wish to pursue the case against the present petitioner. She further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the aforesaid development, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 08.01.2016, is made absolute.
