Prayer in this application is for placing on record the representation dated 13.2.2016 (Annexure P-6).

Learned counsel for the applicant contends that he be allowed to withdraw the earlier representation dated 16.12.2015 (Annexure P-5).

For the reasons stated in the application, representation dated 16.12.2015 (Annexure P-5) is ordered to be withdrawn and in place of that representation, representation dated 13.2.2016 (Annexure P-6) is taken on record.

CRM-M-5069 of 2016

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to transfer the investigation of case FIR No.235 dated 17.5.2014, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari to the CBI or to an officer not below the rank of Inspector General.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ashish Yadav, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that earlier he approached this Court vide Criminal Misc. No. M-42003 of 2015 titled 'Ram Chander vs. State of Haryana and others', which was dismissed as withdrawn on 11.12.2015 to enable the petitioner to file an appropriate representation. He further submits that the petitioner has moved a representation dated 13.2.2016 (Annexure P-6) but no action has been taken thereon.

Though the representation (Annexure P-6) is only dated 13.2.2016, however, taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has earlier approached this Court to the similar

relief, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Rewari to consider and take appropriate decision on the representation dated 13.2.2016 (Annexure P-6) as per law, expeditiously.

Disposed of.
