Petitioner seeks the benefit of regular bail in case F.I.R. No.155 dated 5.11.2015 under sections 21, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Sadar Kharar, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali, District Mohali.

Prosecution version is that on the basis of a secret information the present petitioner as also co-accused were apprehended. The alleged recovery is stated to be of 20 grams of heroin.

Learned State counsel would submit that samples having been sent, report of the Chemical Examiner is still awaited. Counsel further concedes that the present petitioner is not involved in any other proceedings under the N.D.P.S Act.

Keeping in view the fact that the alleged recovery pertains to non-commercial quantity, the petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of regular bail. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Mohali.

Petition disposed of.
