This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C") preferred by Sandeep Singh seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect his life and liberty and not to harass him and his family members unnecessarily and further to comply with the provisions under Section 160 Cr.P.C., in case, petitioner or his family members are in any way wanted in any case.

2. Notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.
4. Though, no representation either to the IGP or to the SSP has been moved prior to filing of the instant petition by the petitioner, however, this petition is treated as representation with the direction to

respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, District Sangrur to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
