Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of his mother Malkiat Kaur alleging that the petitioner along with his wife had damaged a wall and entered the portion of the house occupied by the complainant. It appears to be a dispute amongst the family members. No injury is attributed to the petitioner.

As per the instructions of ASI Bahadur Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of said circumstances, the petition is allowed. Interim order dated 11.02.2016 is hereby made absolute. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the following conditions:

1. Petitioner will not in any manner disturb or enter the portion of the house occupied by the complainant and her husband;
2. Petitioner will not commit similar offence of which he is accused of, during pendency of the trial;

3. Petitioner will not tamper with the evidence or will not in any manner threaten the complainant; and
4. Petitioner will join investigation as and when required.

It is made clear that in case of violation of any of the abovesaid conditions, it will be open to the complainant to approach this Court for cancellation of bail.
