Proxy counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has got instructions to state that the petitioner has already been put in appearance before the summoning Court under orders of this Court.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner will remain on bail against the bail bonds already furnished by him in the private complaint subject to the condition that he will continue to appear before the trial Court and will not absent himself without any sufficient cause.

Pursuant to the interim order dated 15.2.2016 passed by the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner was required to appear on the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court and seek concession of interim bail. In case he has not put in appearance before the trial Court, it is directed that he would put in appearance before the trial Court on the next date of hearing and will be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the summoning Court.
