JASPAL SINGH, J.

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner-Richhpal Singh @ Rishi has sought pre-arrest bail, in case FIR No. 255, dated 11.07.2014, under Sections 302, 341, 148, 149/34 IPC, Police Station Sadar Sirsa.

2. Undisputably, in compliance of order dated March 29, 2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already appeared before the ld. trial court/Additional Sessions Judge, Sirsa and has been released on bail. The trial is in progress, which is now listed for prosecution evidence. Disposal of trial would take sufficient long time. Otherwise also, personal appearance of the petitioner is no more required.

3. Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but

without expressing any opinion on the merits, the petition is allowed and order dated 29.03.2016 is made absolute and shall enure during the pendency of trial.
