Report dated 26.05.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Jalandhar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Ajay Jain as well as of complainant Pawan Kumar Bansal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a pure property dispute and the offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.145 dated 13.08.2014 under Sections 420,467,468,471,120-B IPC Police Station, Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar and all other consequential

proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
