Petitioner has posed a challenge to enquiry report dated 10.11.2015 submitted by Incharge, Economic Offences Wing, District Jalandhar Rural. According to him, respondent No.5 was drawing old age pension from two villages, for which appropriate action needed to be initiated against him. However, the matter has been disposed of by the police with the observation that respondent No.5 would draw pension only from one of the village.

It appears, petitioner had earlier sought a direction from this court for decision of his representation. This court entertained the plea and gave the direction. Pursuant to same, decision has been taken by the appropriate authority. Admittedly, there is some litigation pending between the petitioner and respondent No.5. It appears, petitions are being filed in order to settle their personal scores. Inherent jurisdiction of this court cannot be misused by any litigant for the purposes of settling their issues pending between them. This petition is, thus, totally frivolous. Same is hereby dismissed.
