JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No.252 dated 27.11.2014, under Sections 21/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered with Police Station City Kotkapura.

There is a recovery of 490 grams of *Intoxicating Powder*, which as per the FSL Report, is commercial in nature.

The prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner is made in the light of the custody since 27.11.2014 and only 01 prosecution witness out of 12 having been examined till now.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Surinderjeet Singh, submits that the petitioner is involved in one more case under the NDPS Act. He further submits that the seized quantity being commercial in nature, the petitioner is not entitled to bail.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the seized contraband being commercial in nature, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
