The prayer in the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail for releasing the petitioner in case arising out of FIR No.307 dated 28.06.2015 for the offence punishable under Sections 498-A, 304-B 34 IPC (Alternative charge of Section 302/34 IPC is also framed) registered at P.S.Sector-55, Faridabad, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the State has informed the Court that out of 20 witnesses, no body had appeared for their examination. Evenailable warrants have been issued against the complainant and three more witnesses.

Keeping in view that none of the witnesses have been examined as yet and petitioner is behind the bars since 30.06.2015, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridabad.
