Learned State counsel has filed the reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Dalbir Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City, Panipat and on instructions from SI Dinesh Kumar states that the parents of the petitioner No.1 Priya Rani i.e. respondents No.4 and 5 have made statements that they have no

objection to the marriage of petitioners and they have not extended any threat as alleged. Alongwith the reply, affidavits of respondents No.4 to 8 have also been filed.

In view of the said statement, no further order is required to be passed in this petition.

Disposed of.

However, in case petitioners still apprehend any threat, they are at liberty to approach the concerned Superintendent of Police.
