Co-accused of petitioner, Sikander Singh, from whose house, recovery of 16 bags of poppy-husk weighing 35 kgs each was made, has been granted concession of bail on 06.02.2015 after his judicial custody of two years and six months. The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f August, 2014.

It will be debatable whether on the basis of secret information culpability could be attached to him for being in possession of poppy-husk recovered from the house of co-accused Sikander Singh.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will not indulge in similar activity of which he is accused of during pendency of the trial.
