The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner/accused-Seetu Rani @ Seetu in case FIR No.345 dated 28.08.2015, under Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Ambala GRP Ambala Cantt. (**Annexure P-1**).

Upon notice, learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Budh Dev, points out that the gravity of the alleged offence against the present petitioner is apparent from the suicide note left behind by the deceased.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
