Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Amandeep Singh @ Amandeep Kumar in case FIR No.57 dated 01.05.2011 for offences punishable under Sections 324, 326 and 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Bullowal, Hoshiarpur.

Petitioner along with his co-accused Malkiat Singh and Gurjit Singh had allegedly assaulted Vijay Kumar, complainant. Co-accused of Petitioner Malkiat Singh and Gurjit Singh have been acquitted by Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Hoshiarpur on December 17, 2013 vide judgment Annexure P-3. The petitioner was not able to seek the acquittal as he had gone abroad and was declared a proclaimed offender as per the observations

of the Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur made while dismissing the application for pre-arrest bail.

Counsel for the Petitioner submits that as a matter of fact there is no order existing indicating the petitioner having been declared a proclaimed offender.

Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim directions passed by this Court vide order dated 16.02.2016, Petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been granted interim bail vide order dated 25.02.2016.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by the trial Court vide order dated 25.02.2016 pursuant to the directions passed by this Court vide order dated 16th of February, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
