Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No. 70 dated 27.04.2015 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 506, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

FIR was registered on the basis of statements made by a number of complainants against the present petitioner as also co-accused of having been duped of a large sum of money on the pretext of being sent abroad.

Petitioner was arrested on 22.09.2015.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that the alleged entrustment of the entire money is to co-accused Gurjit Singh. As per version of the complainants, there is no entrustment whatsoever to the present petitioner and her role is of

having introduced the complainants to main accused Gurjit Singh.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Makhan Singh would fairly concede that there is no material evidence that has come on record as regards entrustment of any money to the present petitioner.

Investigation in the present case is complete and challan was presented on 19.12.2015. Charges are yet to be framed. Trial as such would take time to conclude.

It may also be noticed that co-accused, namely, Harmesh @ Meshi against whom also there were no allegations pertaining to entrustment of money has been granted benefit of regular bail by this Court in the light of order dated 30.10.2015 in CRM No. M-36221 of 2015.

In view of the above, petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Rupnagar.

Disposed of.
