Prayer made in the instant petition is, inter alia, for issuance of direction to the official respondents for taking appropriate action in FIR No.195 dated 09.11.2015, registered under Sections 452, 326, 323, 324 and 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Kamboj, Distt. Amritsar.

Heard.

From the perusal of the reply filed on behalf of the State, it emerges that initially, the FIR was registered under Sections 452, 324, 323 and 148 read with Section 149 IPC. After the receipt of report of the doctor whereby injury No.2 on the person of the petitioner was declared grievous in nature, Section 326 IPC was added. It is further evident that out of the six named accused, three have already been arrested and investigation qua the remaining three is going on. It is settled position of law that the Court

cannot issue directions to the investigating agency to investigate the case from a particular angle.

In this view of the matter, the purpose of filing the instant petition has been fully achieved and no further order is required to be passed at this stage.
