Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Ravinder Kumar Goyal in case FIR No.15/2013 dated 26.12.2013 and PC No.9/2015 and RC No.220-2013 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station CBI/EOW-VI-EOW-11/New Delhi registered on the complaint of bank dated 14.12.2013.

Petitioner is a retired Manager since 2009 from State Bank of Patiala. He is accused to having granted NOC to M/s Super Fibers Ltd., for obtaining loan from HSIDC with the recital that no outstanding loan of the bank was pending against said firm. That apart, the allegation is that the rules and procedures were not followed at pre-sanction and post-sanctioning

of loan.

It is contended that at best the Petitioner can be alleged to be negligent in his duties as no loss has been caused to the complainant Bank. It is further contended that as regards the signatures on NOC, they were forged by the Directors of M/s Super Fibers Ltd. It is further submitted that on completion of investigations challan has been filed.

Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim directions passed by this Court vide order dated 15.02.2016, Petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been granted interim bail vide order dated 17.02.2016.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by the trial Court vide order dated 17.02.2016 pursuant to the directions passed by this Court vide order dated 15th of February, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
