Petitioners have been in custody w.e.f. June 24, 2015 i.e. for the last 9 months for having been found in possession of 106 bottles of Rexcof containing codeine phosphate alongwith 1830 tablets of carisoma containing carisoprodal which does not fall within the ambit of NDPS Act.

On asking of the Court, it has been informed that no witness has been examined till date.

Taking into consideration the status of the trial and the period of detention, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction

that trial Court shall conclude the trial by recording the statements of the prosecution witnesses within a period of 5 months after the next date of hearing fixed before the Court. In case the prosecution witnesses are not produced by the prosecution agency within said period, the trial Court shall release the petitioners on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court after the expiry of five months after the next date of hearing, in above said circumstances.
